



Emory at Grady Exceptional APP Award

The Emory at Grady Exceptional APP Award has been established by the Emory at Grady Award Committee to recognize and honor an Advanced Practice Provider whose performance goes beyond the expectations of their position and makes a profound difference in the lives of patients and/or the Emory and Grady communities.

Deadline: Nominations will be accepted through **August 8, 2025**.

Eligibility: All current Emory SOM Advanced Practice Providers (APRN or PA) who dedicate at least 0.5 FTE to clinical activities on the Grady campus. Nominees will have displayed the utmost levels of professionalism, integrity, and dedication to their work, setting a high standard for all APPs.

Examples include but are not limited to:

- **Patient Care:** Provides exceptional clinical care to patients, ensuring well-being and satisfaction. May have a compelling or inspiring story of making a significant impact in a patient's life.
- **Leadership and Support:** Demonstrates exceptional leadership skills and dependability, fosters a positive team environment that enhances patient care, and provides valuable support to their colleagues and staff members.
- **Innovation and Excellence:** Implements new ideas and/or creative solutions to improve operational outcomes and further the mission of Emory at Grady. Has a tangible impact in an area of clinical service and inspires others in the field.

Nominations: APPs must be nominated by a faculty, staff member, or a trainee of Emory University. The nomination should consist of a concise narrative (500 words or less) describing the nominee's above and beyond impact and the effect these actions have had.

Submission: Must be submitted using the [Online Nomination Form](#) and include the following:

- Nominating letter (500 words or less)
- Nominee's current Curriculum Vitae

Decision: Will be made by a subcommittee of the Emory at Grady Faculty Development Committee.

Award: The recipient of the Emory at Grady Above and Beyond Award will be announced and honored at the annual Emory at Grady Awards reception.
