An overdose is a poisoning. Call the Georgia Poison Center and immediately speak to an Addiction Medicine specialist for assistance with acute opioid withdrawal management, initiation of Medication Assisted Therapy (e.g., Suboxone [buprenorphine-naloxone]), and linkage to local Recovery Community Organizations for help with outpatient follow up.

55 Patients

- 90% of patients connected to a peer recovery coach in the ED
- 31% of patients still engaged with RCO at 7 days
- · 27% of patients still engaged with RCO at 30 days
- 27% of patients with OUD started on buprenorphine in the ED
- 50% of patients with OUD discharged with a prescription for buprenorphine

Hurricane Relief

Natural disasters greatly impact patients with chronic medical conditions, including those with substance use disorders, by disrupting their social support networks, mental health care, and access to critical medications and harm reduction strategies.
