## Outstanding Publication Awards in Basic and Clinical/Translational Research

This award recognizes Department of Medicine (DOM) investigators who have produced outstanding basic or clinical/ translational research publications (including quality improvement and health services research) within the last year. A basic award and a clinical/translational research award will be given in each of three faculty ranks:

- Instructor/Assistant Professor
- Associate Professor
- Professor
- <u>Multi-DOM investigators</u>: Papers with more than one DOM investigator may be submitted with all DOM faculty being recognized for the publication. At least one of the DOM faculty being nominated must meet the eligibility requirements listed below. Please submit the nomination in this faculty member's name, and his/her rank will be used as the basis for judging.

**<u>Deadline:</u>** The deadline for all faculty awards nominations is **June 23, 2025** 

<u>Eligibility:</u> All regular, full- or part-time Instructors, Assistant Professors, Associate Professors, and Professors with a primary appointment in the DOM of Emory University are eligible unless they received this award during the previous 3 years. The Nominee must be a first or last author, except for multi-site clinical trials, where the nominee may be the site PI or hold a position on the development, steering, or writing committee.

<u>Mominations:</u> Nominators must submit a peer-reviewed original research article published between <u>May 1, 2024 and April 30, 2025.</u> Only one entry/publication per nominee will be accepted for review. For both basic and clinical/translational research awards, a significant portion of data acquisition must have been performed at Emory and/or its affiliates. Nominations can be self-made or made by other eligible faculty. Nomination for this award does <u>not</u> preclude nomination for other DOM awards in the same year.

## **Submission:**

- A one-page narrative including name and contact information of faculty member being nominated must address the following:
  - impact of research
  - o novelty of research
  - o the role of the nominee
  - description of the work performed at Emory
  - if the submission is part of a multi-site clinical trial, please explain the nominee's specific contribution to the success of the publication.
  - optional (if a multi-DOM investigator paper, you may include details on the roles of all DOM faculty)
- Font Size: 11 pt font minimum
- · Spacing: Single-spaced
- Margins: 1-inch margins on all sides
- Character Count: Approximately 3,500 characters (including spaces)
- Include a copy of the manuscript in PDF.

 Manuscripts will be judged on impact and the more universal standards of adherence to scientific method, clarity of writing, quality of methods and statistics, and significance of results.
