RYSE Award

This award recognizes Department of Medicine (DOM) faculty who have made significant contributions to fostering a DOM community and climate that allows all members to thrive by leveraging service, teaching, mentoring, advocacy, and research efforts.

<u>Deadline:</u> The deadline for all faculty awards nominations is **June 23, 2025.**

Eligibility: All regular, full- or part-time Instructors, Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors with a primary appointment in the DOM at Emory University are eligible unless they received this award during the previous 3 years. Individuals from all racial, ethnic, gender, and socioeconomic backgrounds are eligible for this award.

<u>Nominations:</u> Candidates must be nominated by another faculty member with a concise, one-page narrative describing the outstanding contributions within the DOM. Nomination for this award does <u>not</u> preclude nomination for other DOM awards in the same year. Nominations should emphasize specific aspects of service, teaching, research, or citizenship that contribute to our goals for clinical and learning environments that allow any and all to thrive. Outstanding examples of contributions can include, but are not limited to:

- Important administrative service to the DOM in building and maintaining strong learning and clinical climates for all members.
- Activities designed to achieve a workforce or body of trainees that reflects the populations we serve
- Service to the community via public education programs or campaigns, volunteerism, or non-profit organizations
- Exemplary clinical service to vulnerable populations, colleagues, or the general public
- Development of new or innovative programs to promote welcoming environments for all
- Impactful research aimed at identifying and promoting access to equitable health for all
- Efforts to eliminate health inequalities and improve health outcomes in all populations.

Submission:

- One-page nomination letter including name and contact information of faculty member being nominated.
- Font Size: no smaller than 11-point font
- Spacing: Single-spaced
- Margins: 1-inch margins on all sides
- Character Count: Approximately 3,500 characters (including spaces)
- Two <u>optional</u> one-page letters of support (same requirements above) from internal or external individuals or organizations may also be submitted
