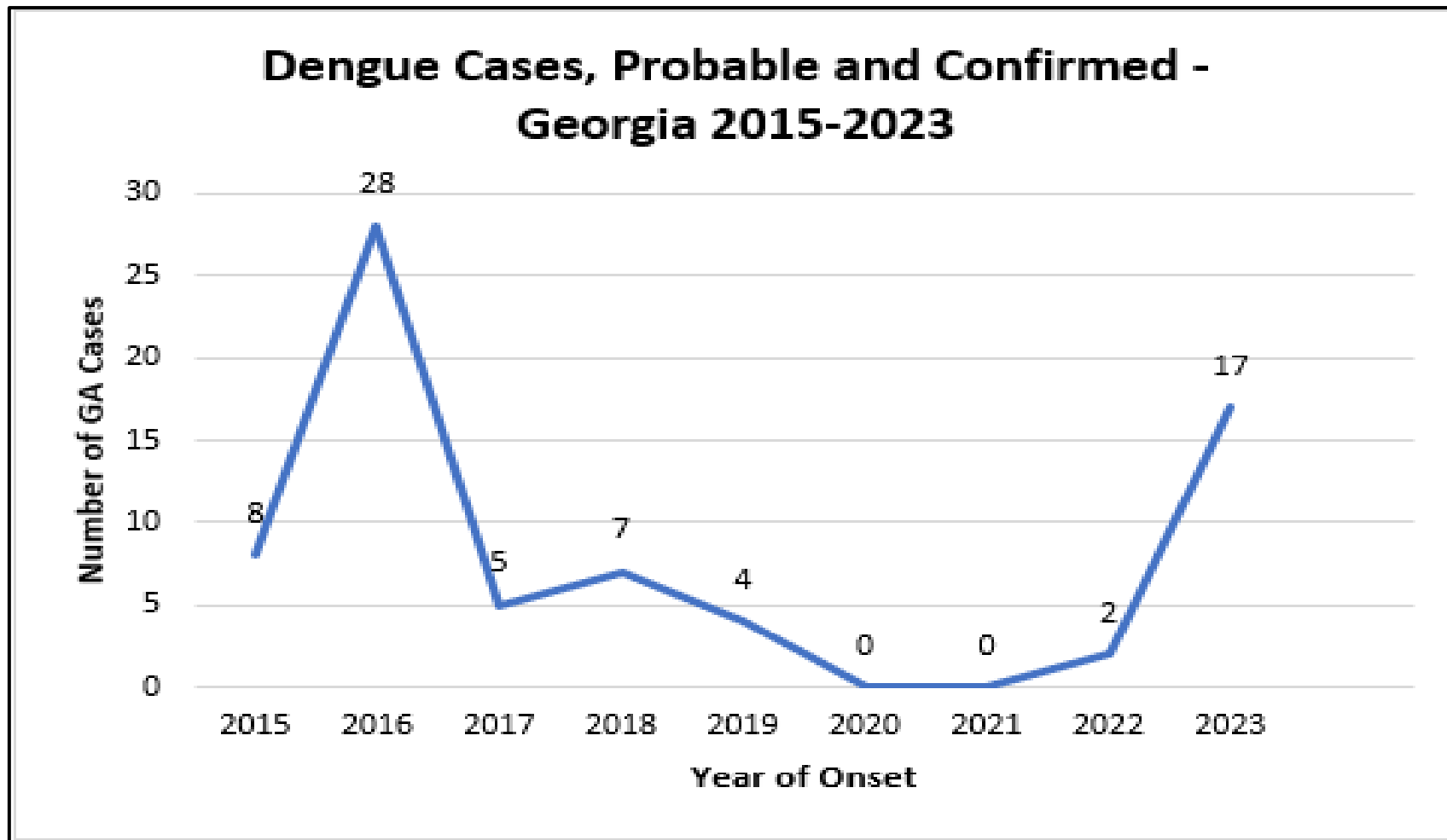

Improved Dengue Surveillance: Foundation of Prevention and Control

- As we saw with dengue surveillance during the Zika and COVID epidemics, we are likely not capturing all dengue cases in the U.S.
- Robust dengue surveillance is key for clinical treatment and to prevent local transmission here
- Improvements include:
 - Increased awareness and testing of travelers from endemic areas
 - Increased Electronic Laboratory Reporting (ELR) of cases
 - Allows increased opportunities to investigate cases earlier, to detect local transmission or outbreaks earlier, and to have data that more accurately reflect trends.
